[The Inn at Occidental](#), a quaint Victorian-style bed and breakfast featuring folk art, family heirlooms, antiques and other original artwork in each room, offers visitors a place to relax and feel at home. Enjoy sipping a local wine in the courtyard garden or read your favorite book on a comfy chair on the wrap-around porch overlooking the redwoods.

## Sonoma Canopy Tours

They offer a "Tree Tops Tour," where you zip along the treetops of the redwoods, the "Forest Flight Tour," where you control your own speed, and a "Night Flight Tour," where you can experience the thrill of zip line during sunset or at night.

In addition, [The Occidental Center for the Arts](#) offers high-quality arts with cultural events, exhibitions, and arts education and has a newly remodeled performing venue. [The Occidental Arts and Ecology Center](#), an 80-acre research, education, and advocacy center, is a world-renowned center for regenerative agriculture.

For good eats, [Hazel Restaurant](#), has exceptionally-prepared Mediterranean-style cuisine, delectable pastries, sweets, cookies, and cakes to die for. The owners, Jim &

Michele Wimborough, are veteran chefs cooking for restaurants in the Bay area including Zut! On Fourth, Grand Café, and Boulevard, for more than 15 years.

Finally, [Howard Station Café](#), is always lively and hopping with local patrons as well as visitors. The café serves healthy, organic food and is a hot spot for breakfast and weekend brunch.

Opening in June this year, Occidental's farmer's market is a great way to experience this friendly town – with fresh produce, local cheeses and baked goods, music, artisan crafts, paella, and Indian food.
